

CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY FOOD RESOURCE GUIDE

This resource guide can help answer your questions and connect you with local supports to find FOOD for both immediate and long-term needs.

When you first call a program to get food assistance, there are several typical questions the agency will ask. Here are examples of some information you will need to know before calling:

How many are in your household and what are their ages?

Has your hold income changed since March 1st, 2020

Are you currently able to meet your household needs for food and/ or paying your bills?

Do you have access to the food you need? Are you able to refrigerate, store and or cook food in your home?

Do you have transportation in order to get food?

How do you typically pay for food? Cash, credit, SNAP or WIC benefits?

Do you have access to the internet?

By knowing the answers to these questions ahead of time, it can help make those first phone calls easier to complete and get you started with services more quickly. The rest of this guide is full of resources to help you access food throughout Chautauqua County.
