

SAFE USE

- 1 Read directions on label
- 2 Take the correct amount the correct number of times a day
- 3 Do not share and do not take anyone else's prescription medicines

Pro tip: 

Know the names of your medications and their purpose!

SAFE STORAGE

- 1 Lock up medicines
- 2 Store in a place away from children, teens, and guests

Pro tip: 

Keep medicines in a cool, dry place away from the light!



SAFE DISPOSAL

- 1 Leave the medicine in its original package or bottle
- 2 Use a black marker to cross off your personal name but do not cross off the name of the medicine
- 3 Take expired or unused prescription medicine to a permanent prescription drop box location

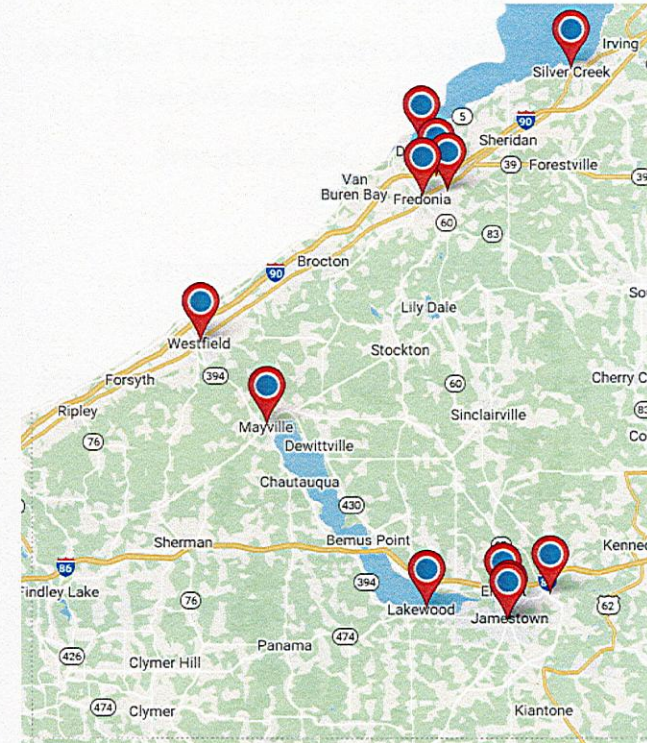
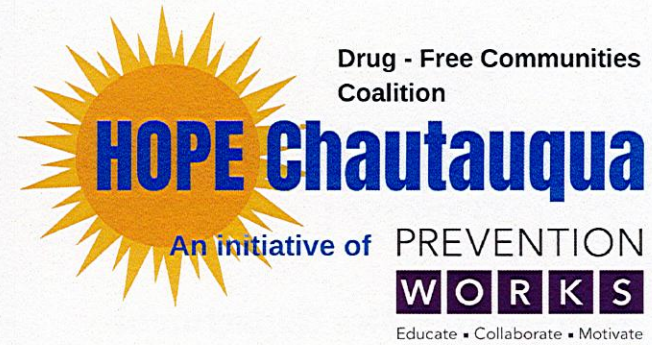

By walking through practical exercises and developing a personalized parenting plan, caregivers will be able to find more confidence in areas like dealing with disobedience and managing fighting and aggression using strategies such as quality time, descriptive praise, direct discussion, and logical consequences.



PAX Tools is a collection of evidence-based, trauma-informed strategies to improve cooperation and self-regulation with youth. PAX Tools draws on decades of science to create strategies that support parents, youth workers, and other caring adults to create a nurturing environment that ultimately helps kids thrive!

PAX Tools is intended for any caring adult who interacts with children, such as parents, caregivers, professionals, and volunteers.
