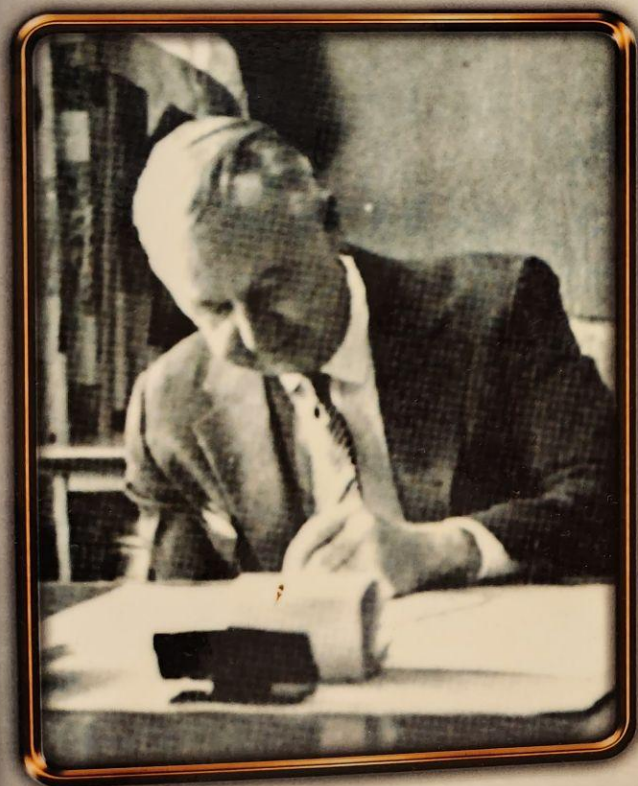

During his long career in Sherman, Mr. Butler also coached basketball and faithfully attended many sporting events and academic activities, always showing his unwavering support for his students.

Under his watch the first of many building projects, the remodeling of the elementary school, was completed. He was also instrumental in the construction of the 500-seat auditorium, still used today and which bears his name.
